Call to Worship – Psalm 149

**Sing to the Lord a new song, his praise in the assembly of the faithful. Let Israel
be glad in its Maker, let the children of Zion rejoice in their King. For the Lord
delights in his people, he adorns the humble with victory!**

Opening Hymn of Praise: “The Solid Rock”

Prayer of Confession – Isaiah 59:12-13

Assurance of Forgiveness – Isaiah 57:15
